A fan favourite is the "Classic Apple Cider", a safe option, but nonetheless, a reliable one. A staff recommendation is the Pumpkin Cider, but this is definitely one for more seasoned drinkers!

You can also order full entree's that are on par with all restaurants in the area, just with arguably much better cider. But that's not all, vegetarians and those with dietary restrictions are in luck.
